



How about some cheese with that wine

Abbotsford, BC (September 2008) – At **The Farm House Natural Cheeses** in Agassiz, they have paired up wine with certain cheese that they sell.

Farm House Cheddar is a natural white cheddar made from fresh cow's milk. Paired with a light fruity red or a dark beer or ale is a true family favorite! *Country Morning Cheese* is a traditional Welsh-type cheese similar to Caerphilly with a crumbly creamy texture and a slight nutty sharpness. Pair this cheese with Chardonnay, Riesling, or Gewurztraminer.

Alpine Gold is a washed curd, washed rind cheese. It has a deliciously smelly golden-orange rind, which gives a distinct flavor to the straw-colored semi-soft paste. Pair Alpine Gold with Gewurztraminer, Riesling, Beaujolais, Burgundy or even beer. *Farm House Gouda* is a real old-fashioned Gouda with a slight sweetness and the addition of herbs, cumin seed, or chilies. Pair it with a light fruity red or beer.

Fromage Frais is a fresh cream cheese made from whole dairy milk and an aromatic European culture, giving it a lemony freshness. It is available blended with a variety of herbs and spices for an unforgettable appetizer cheese, or natural for spreading or baking. Pair Fromage Frais with a sparkling white wine, zinfandel, or fortified wines.

Farm House Brie is authentic naturally-ripened brie, hand-ladled, smooth and runny with a delicious mushroomy aroma. Pair this brie with a Pinot noir or Gamay. *Farm House Camembert* is a natural mould-ripened favorite with a smooth interior, white bloomy crust and a pronounced truffle taste. Pinot noir or Gamay will go with this cheese as well. *Castle Blue* is a rich creamy blue-veined cheese, semi-soft with a sweet undertone. Castle Blue pairs nicely with full-bodied red wines, sweet wines, or port or sherry.

The **Domaine de Chaberton** Estate Winery is home of the award-winning wines of Chaberton, Canoe Cove and the Zagat-rated Bacchus Bistro. Located on 55 acres of land amongst the rolling hills of south Langley, there are daily winery tours from February through to November at 2pm and 4pm. December and January at 3pm only. Their wine shop offers beautiful wine related gifts and a variety of gift baskets along with Vintners Quality Assurance labels on their wines. Their kind staff is even willing to create the perfect basket specifically to meet your needs.
